

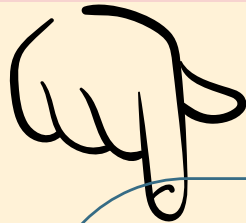

Present Simple

* Some verbs *
Work, go, play, eat
do, read, run, swim, etc

present simple
We use present simple to talk about habits, facts and things that happen regularly.
Verb: is a word that shows action in a sentence.
Form: Subject + Verb + object
Key words: always, sometimes, often, every week, every week, every night, etc
Note:
I - We, you, They → I do work.
She, He, It → Verb + s/es (does)

Verb: is a doing word.

I → I do

She
He
It
Verb + s (does)
