- 5- Ask What day it is today? Elicit answers and make sure that the class agrees.
- 6- Get pupils to look at the top activity on page 31 of the Pupil's Book.
 7- Explain that pupils should look at the pictures and what is happening in each one and then write the day of the week.

- 5- Put pupils in small groups and get them to act out the conversation using their own words.
- * 6- Track 26 in three parts. Stop after each part and let pupils complete the relevant text using words from the orange box.
 - 7- Ask pupils to look at the second activity on page 35 of the Pupil's Book and work out what the three adjectives
- 8- Put pupils in pairs and ask them to complete the eight sentences at the bottom of the page.

- 6- Play Track 29 and let pupils check if they have chosen the right picture.
 - 7- The activity at the bottom of Pupil's Book page 37 looks at five new words (butterflies, ants and flies.)

- 1- Tell students to reread the text on page 37 once.
- 2-Ask pupils to work individually and complete the first activity on page 38 of the Pupil's Book.
 - 3- Ask pupils to compare their answers in pairs.
 - 4- Ask pupils to look at the last activity on page 38 of the Pupil's Book.
 - 5- Ask pupils to read the speech bubble text first of all, then to do the activity.
- * 6- Explain that pupils are going to do a project about an animal that they choose and make a poster.
 - 7- Ask pupils to open their Pupil's Books on page 39.
- 8- Give pupils time to look at the pictures about doves and read the captions for each picture.

- 2- Ask pupils to look at page 40 of the Pupil's Book and read the name of the song.
- 3- Ask pupils to look at how many pictures there are and which animals they can see in the pictures.
 - 4- Play Track 34. Ask pupils to listen and follow.
- 5- Encourage them to say the words quietly to themselves as they listen or to clap along to the song.
 - 6- Explain that pupils are going to play a game in pairs and answer questions.
 - 7- Ask pupils to look at page 41 of the Pupil's Book.
 - 8- Get pupils to look at the 'points maze' at the top of the page.
